In the early 1980s, a small group of dedicated volunteers set out to build the first Ronald McDonald House® in Wisconsin because families had no place to stay while their seriously ill child was being treated at Children's Wisconsin. The outpouring of support to build our House was remarkable. So much so that when we opened in 1984, we called it "The House that Love Built®." Since then, RMHC Eastern Wisconsin has been keeping families together by providing more than 50,000 family stays.



These families come from all 50 states and many countries around the world whose children are receiving medical care at Children's Wisconsin or other area hospitals. The House offers a place to call home at little or no cost, so families can stay together. Many families try to contribute what they can—even if it's the suggested \$20 a night donation. In reality, the cost is approximately \$95 per night. No one is ever turned away for their inability to pay.



The House is more than just a place to stay. It offers families therapeutic programming, a comprehensive meal program, comfortable community spaces and so much more. A team of 500 volunteers and a dedicated staff are always ready to do whatever it takes to make a family's stay a little easier. Living in a community, side by side, families form friendships and support one another through difficult times.

How to Receive a Patch

The Simply Giving RMHC® Patch teaches girls, ages K-12, the mission of the Ronald McDonald House® and how each girl can make a difference in the lives of those who are in need, while their loved ones receive critical medical care. This patch is **free** to all participating Girl Scouts.

Here are the steps each Girl Scout must complete to receive their Simply Giving RMHC® Patch:

1. Listen to a presentation on the Ronald McDonald House.

Please inform Rachelle if you would prefer the presentation in-person, virtually, or as a prerecorded video sent directly to the troop.

2. Plan, as a troop or individually, how you would like to advocate for the Ronald McDonald House.

- Make a fleece tie blanket
- Plan a toy drive to stock the Magic Room
- Hold a food drive to stock their pantries
- Donate an item from their Wish List
- 3. You did it! You will now receive your Simply Giving RMHC Patch.

Each Girl Scout will receive their patch upon the completion of the presentation and chosen project. Each girl will be given their patch at the end of an in-person presentation, or the patches will be mailed to the troop leader ahead of time if it is a virtual presentation.

When you receive this patch, you will know you've helped move the RMHC mission forward.
