Camper Fees (Scouts K-6th grade):

<u>PA and CIT</u>: no camp fee *(Girl Scout membership for 2023-2024 required)* <u>Adult Volunteers</u>: no camp fee ** <u>last day</u> for volunteers to register is 5/18/24 **

Peewees (boys & girls ages 3-5) and Boys (ages 6-12): \$15/day - These campers are welcome on day(s) the parent/guardian is volunteering; but they must be potty-trained and mature enough to participate in a full day of camp. If the child cannot be away from the parent/guardian, then the parent/guardian must move to the peewee or boy unit for the rest of the day. They cannot join the campers unit. **Everyone who attends camp (campers AND volunteers) are required to be a registered Girl Scout member. Adults must have a current background check (paid for by GSWISE) for the safety of our campers. Register for camp online at

Transportation:

** approximate pickup times = 7:40 am-7:55am ** approximate dropoff times = 4:30pm- 4:55pm Bus stops will be updated when we have confirmation from the Oconomowoc School District. Times will be emailed at least 2 weeks prior to camp using the email you register with. Bussing to/from camp is included in your registration! No extra fee for riding the bus. You are required to input your camper's transportation information in your camper's registration.

Communication:

Our main communication tool is the email that you use to register for camp. Please ensure this email is valid and periodically check for new mail from camp!! You will receive various email updates from now until camp. All required camp information needed will come 2-3 weeks prior to camp. Also, please join us on Facebook at Lakeland Day Camp gswise (our public page) or our closed group at Lakeland Day Camp 2024 (you will be required to answer the questions for approval).



Early Pick Up/Late Drop Off:

Please notify the directors of any change in schedule for you and/or camper **BEFORE** camp begins; email the directors at <u>lakelandgirlscoutdcc@gmail.com</u>. <u>Chinook Program Center:</u> Enter through the gate, park at the main parking lot, and walk to the Activity Station to check in with

<u>Camp Alice Chester:</u> Park in the main parking lot and walk to the Welcome Center to check in with the health supervisor.

Food and Dietary Restrictions:

Camp provides all food and beverages except for lunch Tues. & Fri. *All campers participate in making their lunches Monday, Wednesday and Thursday over a fire or Coleman stove with guidance from the PAs, CITs and unit Volunteers. Tuesday and Friday, they must pack a bag lunch (packed in disposable bags and include a beverage), These bag lunches cannot contain any type of nuts or nut butter please! For those (PA and CITs) spending the night prior to a bag lunch day there will be supplies at camp to make a bag lunch.*



NO ONE SHOULD GO HOME HUNGRY FROM LAKELAND DAY CAMP! *Extra* snacks and beverages are always available! There is a snack at the opening and closing flag and a walk around snack available as well every day.

NEW THIS YEAR: lunches must not include any type of nuts or nut butter. Please DO NOT pack extra food or drink that camp has not pre approved! Snacks or extra food must be approved by the directors and kitchen coordinators. This extra food must be able to be shared with the campers unit. We need to approve these extra snacks to ensure that they meet the dietary needs of the entire unit.

Camper Safety

Your camper's safety is our number one priority. We follow state licensing, American Camp Association Accreditation, and Girl Scout safety standards. Our standards include, but are not limited to:



• Certified lifeguards, health supervisors, behavioral health specialists, first aiders, and high-risk activity instructors

• Background checks for all adult staff and volunteers

• Training for all staff and volunteers to prioritize your camper's physical, mental, and emotional wellbeing

• Camps are licensed and inspected by state health inspectors

• Weather is monitored, and plans are in place for heat, storms, and other emergencies

Dress Code: PW through Volunteers

Short sleeved shirts (no tank tops or tops with shoulders exposed, no crop tops- must be long enough to cover beltline)

<u>Shorts/ skirt/ capris/ pants</u> (non-revealing, bottom must remain covered even when sitting) <u>Closed toe shoes</u> (no sandals or flip flops - must protect your toes!) <u>Non-revealing swimwear</u> (one-piece or two-piece with coverup)

** Campers (PW, Boys, and K-6th graders) must leave cell phones at home. If one is brought, it will be powered off and remain in their backpack. If this is not followed, it will remain in the camp office until close of camp.

<u>Packing List</u>: **Label everything with first & last name. Reminder that the camper must be able to carry everything they bring!!!

- Sit Upon
- Cup with a closed handle
- Rope or belt around waist to hook cup to with carabiner
- Brimmed hat (not required, recommended)
- Socks (not required, recommended)
- Bandana
- Backpack to carry items to/from camp
- Sunscreen & Bug Repellent (please have applied prior to camp)
- Raincoat/poncho
- Long sleeve shirt/sweatshirt & pants
- Bag lunch for <u>TUES</u> & <u>FRI (must be</u> in disposable bag and include beverage)
- Mess kit (plate, cup, fork, knife, spoon, bowl) in a mesh bag (must be able to be dunked in water and hang on the clothesline to dry)
- Sharpie
- For Kindergarten Daisies: bring your favorite Stuffie on Monday
