# 5 Flowers, 4 Stories, 3 Cheers for Animals

## Snapshot of the Daisy Journey

Session 1	<b>Starting Our Animal Adventure:</b> Daisies begin to identify ways they can care for animals.
Session 2	<b>Caring That Counts:</b> Daisies explore the many ways that caring for animals is like caring for themselves.
Session 3	<b>Tail Tales:</b> Daisies use their imaginations and problem-solving skills as they continue to explore how the needs of animals are similar to their own
Session 4	<b>All Creatures Great and Special:</b> Daisies begin to explore how animals, like people, are unique, including in the ways they communicate and move.
Session 5	<b>Out and About with Animals:</b> Daisies learn more about needs of animals in preparation for teaching others about animal care.
Session 6	<b>A Postcard is Worth a Thousand Words:</b> Daisies continue to explore the needs of animals and use critical thinking skills to begin focusing on specific animal needs in their community.
Session 7	<b>Inspired by Animals:</b> Daisies continue to explore how caring for animals resembles caring for themselves.
Session 8	<b>What Animals Tell Us:</b> Daisies strengthen their communication skills and learn how animals are used in advertising.
Session 9	<b>Teaching Others with Confidence:</b> Daisies educate and inspire others on animal care.
Session 10	<b>Many Skills to Learn:</b> Daisies come to understand how caring for animals and caring for themselves makes them feel
Final Celebration	Daisies celebrate what they've learned and their growing confidence in caring for animals and themselves.



## Sample Activities for Mapping Your Journey

### Traditions:

Learn special Girl Scout signs, like the handshake and quiet sign.

### Outdoors:

Explore your backyard to discover what animals call it *home*.

### Petals:

**Spring Green:** Collect items for the local animal or wildlife shelter.
