What information do we collect?

We collect the essential information to complete a background investigation based on our client's requirements. This may include:

- Name
- Address
- Date of birth
- Social Security Number
- Contact information
- Employment and education history
- Driver's license information
- Additionally, based on our client's payment policy, you may be required to submit credit card information.

How do we use your information?

This varies based on our client's requirements. It can be used to search for criminal history, verify employment and education records, confirming active driver privileges, etc.

Your information, whether public or private, will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or given to any other company for any reason whatsoever, without your consent, other than for the express purpose of delivering the purchased product or service requested.

How do we protect your information?

All information is transmitted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology and stored with encryption in our database. Access is limited to authorized individuals with special access rights to our systems and in compliance to state and federal laws.

Do we disclose any information to outside parties?

No unless required by law due to legal proceedings or in the cases of a threat of imminent harm to you or others. In either case, we will limit the scope of disclosure, and will disclose only the information required to fulfill legal obligations.
