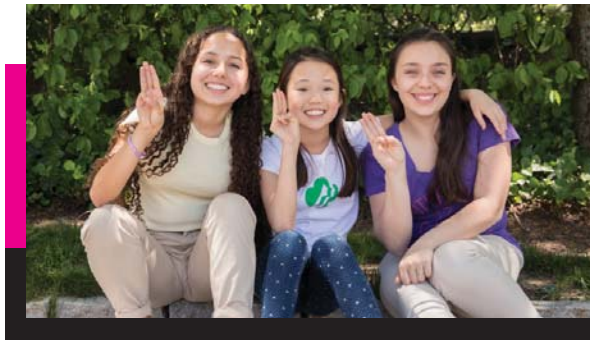
Girl Scouts strives to ensure that leadership opportunities are available for Latina girls, providing a relevant and culturally inclusive experience.

Specially trained staff will work with parents and adults in the Latino community to recruit, train, and support volunteers.
- ✓ **Customized Program Resources**
We provide resources that are culturally and linguistically modified to make sense to the Hispanic population, and Girls Scouts offers financial assistance when needed.
- ✓ **Mother and Daughter Skill Building**
Mothers and daughters have the opportunity to develop leadership skills together, aligning with the strong family values shared among the Latino community.
- ✓ **Training and Resources for Volunteers**
We provide all the materials and support volunteers need to deliver a quality experience.
