- **Picnic Shelter/Pavilion day rentals for Troop meetings and activities**
- **Girl Scout Family overnight weekend rentals**
- **Girl Scout Troop overnight weekend rentals**

****Please note, due to the fluid and ever-evolving COVID-19 guidelines, the availability and dates are subject to change or cancelation. If any reservations are impacted by changes or are cancelled, we will contact you.*

Explore, experience, and enjoy our camp properties by:

- Hiking the trails
- Cooking or making S'mores over the campfire (roasting forks available)
- Exploring the pond or lakeshore (depending on camp property)
 - Sorry – no swimming or boating, as there are no lifeguards currently onsite
- Accomplishing Girl Scout badge outdoor activities
- Playing outdoor games
- Relaxing in nature

To ensure social distancing and to reduce the potential spread of COVID-19, the following protocols are being implemented (more details will be sent with your confirmation packet or are available upon request):

- For health & safety, buildings will be sanitized between each usage, and unit rentals will be limited to one group per weekend.
- Unrelated groups/troops should not intermingle.
- Troops should practice 6-foot social distancing as possible, and face coverings are recommended for troops while indoors.
- Groups should bring hand sanitizer and tablecloths for picnic tables that are tough to sanitize.
- Pre-screening of girls/families should be conducted prior to arrival to ensure no one has had a fever during the prior 14 days.
- Check-in will be contactless, and groups should proceed to their shelter unit or building upon arrival to obtain their check-in kit.
- Drop-off for Troop overnight camping:
 - Carpooling is not recommended.
 - Upon arrival, driver/parents stay in the car when dropping off girls.
 - Girl's temperature is taken by Troop leader outside of the car (a touchless thermometer will be in the check-in kit).
 - If a girl's temperature is above 100.4, she will be sent back home.
