[Camp Alice Chester](#), located in East Troy, is 333 acres and features frontage on two lakes, a large sports field, and wooded hills. Two indoor troop camping facilities are available, each designed to respond to the varying skill and comfort levels of our members. A-frame cabins, platform tents, and day use sites are available seasonally.

Camp Alice Chester is closed between Memorial Day and Labor Day to accommodate overnight camp during the summer.

Private parties (weddings, showers, etc.) are not permitted at any GSWISE property. We do permit nonprofit groups with a 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(6) status with the IRS (government organizations such as schools or universities, Girl Scout troops from other councils, etc.) to use GSWISE properties.
