Meet your camp director team of volunteers



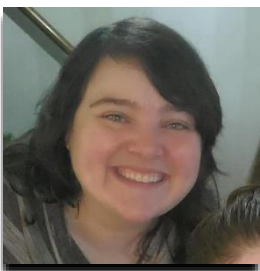
Becky "Snickers" Bauer, Camp Director Volunteer
