Potty-trained sibling pee wees, aged 3 – 5 and sibling boys, aged 6 – 12 {completed K5}, may attend only on days when a parent volunteers \$15/child/day.

#### Adult Volunteer Details

- Our day camp is 100% organized and facilitated by volunteers.
- The girls need you! Be part of camp by spending quality time with your Girl Scout: volunteer for a day (or five!) helping your daughter and her friends. One adult volunteer is needed for every 5-8 girls during each day of camp. Each family should register at least one adult to help for a minimum of one day during day camp.

- Volunteers don't have to be moms – dads, grandparents, family friends, young adult volunteers, Girl Scout alumni, and more are welcome! New Girl Scout volunteers will register as a Girl Scout, register for day camp, and complete the background check (including applicable fee) through GS-WISE.
- Adults are needed for camper overnights (for girls currently in grades 4-6) too. Please consider sharing this exciting camp experience with your daughter.
- Adults are also needed as bus monitors. We need at least one adult on each bus for each day. In the event that we do not have enough adults volunteer as bus monitors, the bus may be canceled. Please consider helping in this capacity.
