They will learn peer interaction and relationship-building skills, and be inspired to Take Action to encourage kindness!

Each workshop costs \$125 regardless of the number of participants (min. 10 girls in person or 5 for virtual workshops, and max. 50 in person or 25 for virtual workshops, same level), and includes an informative takeaway for each girl. Let us know how we can partner with you!
