About the Awards

Bronze Award (Grades 4-5): Girl Scout Juniors team up to explore their community, discover a need or issue they care about, and work together to address it.

Silver Award (Grades 6-8): Girl Scout Cadettes team up or work on their own to research an issue they care about, make a plan to address it, and then take action to improve their community.


Gold Award (Grades 9-12): The Gold Award is the highest honor in Girl Scouting. Gold Award Girl Scouts find an issue in the community/world they care about, research the issue, build a team, and make and carry out a plan to address the issue's root cause.

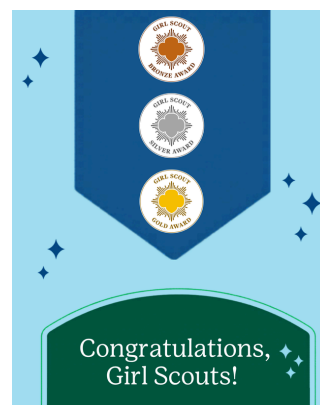

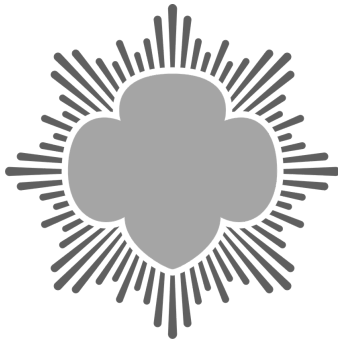
