

Series Volunteer Position Description

Position Summary: Be a mentor to girls in $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ grade as you take the girls on a journey of self discovery. A Series Volunteer may work directly or indirectly with Cadette girls in overseeing and planning fun filled activities aligned to the Girl Scout Leadership Experience (GSLE) to full fill the Girl Scout mission in building the girls of courage, confidence and character who make the world a better place.

Term of Appointment: Series volunteer is appointed for a 3-4 month term with flexible hours per week after successful completion of the application and background check process. The term is renewable upon completion of evaluation process.

Series Roles and Responsibilities:

<u>Series Advisors</u> support the implementation of a community by completing tasks or presentations assigned in partnership with adults and girls. The nature of this position requires the individual to provide indirect services to girls.

<u>Series Coordinators</u> are responsible for overseeing the planning and implementation of series offerings that provide high-quality activities for girls and are aligned to the GSLE. The nature of this position requires the individual to provide indirect services to girls.

<u>Series Leaders</u> are responsible for implementing the program to Cadette girls in building healthy relationships, learning about the air we breath, and/or getting a deeper understanding about the media.
